GRENACHE / SYRAH

**RANGE™** The interplay between Grenache and Syrah is a dramatic and complex performance. 2017 is a vintage with firm structure and tremendous aging potential. Though it accounts for only 35% of the wine, the Syrah is ever present here, contributing a great amount of minerality and earthen texture. The two grapes coalesce into flavors of Black Mission Fig, freshly picked marjoram, and a tannin structure that seems more like that of a fine cocoa than grape or oak. This wine is refined, it is layered, and it will drink well for a very long time.

Jeb Dunnuck said it best after tasting the inaugural vintage of this wine, calling it "a Chateauneuf du Pape look-alike with its ripe, full-bodied aromas...solid concentration, rock-star texture..." The wines of the Southern Rhone valley are a direct influence on the style and intention of this wine, and this 2017 vintage shows it.
